ANDREWS MOVING & STORAGE TRANSPORTS SPECIAL NASA EXHIBIT

ST. LOUIS, Dec. 11, 2003 – Andrews Moving & Storage, Cleveland, Ohio, an agent of United Van Lines, has been hauling a special NASA exhibit since May of this year. The “Centennial of Powered Flight” exhibit was produced by NASA’s Glenn Research Center in Cleveland, Ohio.

The display, marking the 100th anniversary of powered flight, is housed in two 53-foot vans, one of which is climate-controlled. The climate-controlled van holds a number of large graphic panels, which must be protected against temperature change. In addition to housing the exhibit, the vans are decorated with a vinyl mural depicting the exhibit’s theme and serve as a “rolling billboard.”

The exhibit has been traveling continuously across the country, with shows lasting eight to 25 days. The last event will be held in Kitty Hawk, N.C., during December to celebrate the Wright Brothers’ first powered flight. Other cities visited during the tour include: Fayetteville, N.C.; Dayton, Ohio; Oshkosh, Wis.; and Los Angeles, Calif. In addition to providing transportation, Andrews
