### **DELANEY MOVING & STORAGE OWNER RECEIVES WOMEN IN BUSINESS 2006 AWARD**

She also orchestrates Delaney Moving & Storage’s monthly food deliveries to The Salvation Army’s local food pantry, free of charge.

Delaney leads the efforts of the Christmas Bureau Partners Committee, an ongoing collaborative effort by the Salvation Army, United Way of Central New York and other community partners, to provide more than 2,500 families with food, toys and books during the holidays. Most recently, Delaney played a major role in the successful first annual St. Patrick’s Day Hunger Project, a
