DONATES SHIPMENT OF “HOME IN A BOX” FOR LOUISIANA FAMILY**
Local United Van Lines attends dedication of the home

MONTEGUT, La. – In June 2006, Dearman Moving and Storage Company, a Mansfield, Ohio agent of United Van Lines, donated the shipping of a “home in a box” from Mansfield to Montegut, La., for a family who lost their home in the hurricanes of 2005. Recently, the “re-construction” of that home was completed. Tim Campbell, director of operations at Dearman, attended the ceremony in Louisiana and met the recipients, Forest and Ann Billiott, as they prepared to move into their new home.

The Billiott’s home had been under construction since mid-April in Mansfield through part of a new program developed by Berean Baptist Church called “Healing Hearts Through Housing.” Campbell is the logistics and beneficiary coordination manager for the Healing Hearts project.

“It was an incredible experience to see those months of hard work come to such a fulfilling conclusion,” Campbell said of the dedication ceremony. “The Billiott’s were very excited and grateful.”

Previously, the Billiott family lived in a trailer with their two children, ages 12 and 18, when both Hurricane Katrina and Hurricane Rita caused significant water damage. Berean Baptist Church raised more than \$30,000 and secured volunteers to build the outward structure of the home, as well as to buy many of the interior materials needed to complete the construction in Louisiana.
